Dinghy Sailing

Dinghies can be kept in the locked Dinghy Park at the Club all year round if necessary. Fees are paid for summer and winter storage. The dinghy park gets very full in the summer and early notification of places needed is appreciated.

Club Boats

The club has a number of dinghies for the use of members. Please arrange with the Officer of the Day (OOD). There will be a £5.00 charge on a per dinghy basis for the use of a club sailing dinghy by an Adult Member. There is no charge for Cadet Members and no charge if a Cadet and Adult Member sail together. This is to help with the cost of the sailing boats maintenance. Club Boat usage will be recorded on the daily sailing log and recharged to the Member.

Keel Boats

Keelboat owners need to provide their own mooring suitable for their boat. The maximum all up weight of a mooring including chain is 1 tonne. The club can provide advice on minimum requirements and reserves the right to inspect moorings prior to laying them. Crown Estate fees apply to all moorings laid, but the fees are lower than the individual rate as the club is a mooring association. The convenor and all keel boat members are involved with the arrangements for lifting and laying of their moorings.

There is a separate sheet available on request with full details of the moorings and other arrangements relating to keelboats at the club. All moorings must be discussed and agreed with the Keel Boat Convenors. Keel boats are launched and lifted out by arrangement to avoid conflicts with other sailing activities. Please contact the mooring convenor to discuss especially if you need a crane. Boats can be stored in the winter either in the dinghy park for a small fee or on the hard standing (space permitting).

Duties

All members are allocated duties including Officer of the Day (OOD), Assistant Officer of the Day (AOOD), Safety and Kitchen. Most members may have up to 4 duties per season, but usually only 2. Duties are allocated according to preference, sailing knowledge and, if known, suitable dates. Members must check their duties when the Sailing Programme is sent out and, if unable to honour, exchange with another member. Member contact details are held by the Membership Secretary and the Events & Publicity Convenor if required. As a new member you may be asked to help out. Support will be given and you will not be given a duty you feel unable to cope with, however it is your responsibility if you feel you are unable to fulfil your duty for any reason.

There will be a £5.00 refundable charge for a clubhouse key and a £20.00 refundable charge for the council slip (Pier) key.
